## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL REAL ESTATE REGISTRANTS

### RELICENSING EDUCATION 2017

This notice will mark the 17<sup>th</sup> year for the Relicensing Education (RLE) program, which will commence April 1, 2017.

RLE 17 will introduce changes to both the manner in which the program is to be delivered, and the learning material. This year will require all registrants to complete, in this order three (3) hours of in-person classroom learning followed by three (3) hours of online, computer-based learning through MREA's new learning management system (to be implemented by April 2017).

The Manitoba Securities Commission (MSC) requires that every registrant under the *Real Estate Brokers Act* (or *Real Estate Services Act* ("ACT") if the new ACT is proclaimed during the running time-frame of RLE 17) must complete the learning in the order indicated above, and no deviation will be permitted in this first year. The MSC requires that every registrant under the ACT completes the RLE program for that year prior to renewing his/her registration. The MSC has the authority to suspend the registration of any registrant who fails to complete the requisite learning for a given year.

**NOTE: The time period of RLE 17 is different from that offered in prior years. The in-person classroom session will only be offered until December 31, 2017 and the online computer-based session will be offered until March 31, 2018.**

The MSC enjoys a strong working relationship with the MREA and has delegated to the association the responsibility for delivering and administering all real estate educational courses. The registration applications for RLE 17 are available on the MSC website [www.mbrealestate.ca](http://www.mbrealestate.ca) or through MREA on its website [www.manitobarealestate.com](http://www.manitobarealestate.com). However, be informed that you must register for RLE through MREA. This year's RLE will see a change with respect to the associated cost as noted below:

**NOTE: The cost will be \$135 including GST and there will not be any discount for early registration as in past years. Due to new classroom timelines and structure, we can no longer allow registrants to arrive up to 15 minutes late. Starting with RLE 17, the sign-in period will begin 30 minutes prior to class start time. Morning sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m. and afternoon sessions at 1:00 p.m. Once class has begun, registrants will not be permitted to enter. Any registrant who arrives past the class start time, regardless of reason, will be required to re-register for another date/time.**

The final class for RLE 16 is **March 15, 2017** and any registrant who has not yet completed the course must contact the MREA to schedule a date to attend an in-person classroom session. Those registrants who fail to attend an RLE 16 session will be required to successfully pass an examination in order to maintain their registration.
