IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL REAL ESTATE REGISTRANTS

RELICENSING EDUCATION 2018 (RLE 18)

2018 will mark the 18th year for the Relicensing Education (RLE) program. **RLE 18 will commence on January 1, 2018 and run to the end of December 2018.**

The program for RLE 18 will follow the same format as RLE 17 and will consist of a three (3) hour in-person classroom session followed by three (3) hours of online computer-based learning through The Manitoba Real Estate Association's (MREA) learning management system.

The Manitoba Securities Commission requires that each registrant under *The Real Estate Brokers Act* (or *Real Estate Services Act* if it is proclaimed during the RLE 18 course year) complete the RLE requirement for that year prior to renewing his/her registration under the Act. The Commission has the authority under the Act to suspend the registration of any registrant who fails to complete the RLE requirement for a given year.

Registrations renewed on, or after January 1, 2018 will be conditional on the registrant completing RLE 18 before their next renewal date.

The Manitoba Securities Commission has delegated the responsibility for administering licensing education courses and examinations (including relicensing education) to the MREA.

Registration for RLE 18 opens on November 1, 2017 and will be done exclusively online through the MREA's learning management system. The MREA will be sending a registration tutorial video to all registrants by e-mail. Please ensure that you watch the tutorial before proceeding to register online. The MREA's learning management system can be accessed by visiting the Commission's website www.mbrealestate.ca, the MREA's website www.manitobarealestate.com, or through REALTOR Link®.

The last in-person class for RLE 17 is **December 14, 2017** and no further seminars will be scheduled. Registrants who have not attended an in-person RLE 17 classroom session by this date will be required complete this portion of the program by passing an exam. If this applies to you contact the MREA at 204-772-0405.

Effective January 1, 2018 RLE will be incorporated into the pre-licensing course for salespeople. This means that individuals who complete the salesperson course after January 1, 2018 will have already covered RLE material and will not be required to complete the separate RLE course that applies to the year they completed the pre-licensing course. For example, an individual who completes the salesperson course in 2018 would not need to complete RLE 18. Their first required RLE would be RLE 2019.
